Perry Hall Christian School (PHCS) has adopted a simple Continuous Enrollment (CE) policy whereby students will be continuously enrolled at PHCS until graduation, or if necessary, until the PHCS withdrawal process is completed. By signing the CE policy and contract, PHCS parents/legal guardians agree to the following:

- I hereby opt into CE at PHCS and agree to the CE policies below. I agree to pay the annual tuition and fees for the upcoming school year through a payment plan starting in July (one payment, two payment or ten payment plans available).
- I understand that each December, PHCS will publish the following school year's tuition and fee schedule and information regarding financial aid. I will refer to that document for specific details.
- I understand that I have until January 31st every year to opt out from PHCS for the upcoming year at no charge. I must notify PHCS by sending a withdrawal form to the PHCS front office on or before January 31st. If I withdraw my student(s) after January 31st, I will be charged a withdrawal fee and other applicable fees (see the PHCS tuition and fee schedule). Withdrawal fees are applicable unless my student is withdrawn due to relocation of more than a 30-mile radius of the school.
- The enrollment fee per student in my family will be charged to my FACTS account on February 1st for the upcoming school year. The curriculum fee per student in my family will be charged to my FACTS account on June 1st for the upcoming school year. These fees are non-refundable (see the PHCS tuition and fee schedule). Tuition and other fees will be charged to my FACTS account in July for the upcoming school year (see the PHCS tuition and fee schedule). Tuition and fees are updated each year to reflect new rates and may include variations in schedule.
- I will keep each of my student's information up to date (i.e. address, phone, email, emergency contact, and medical information) from grade to grade in our student information system, Renweb. PHCS will send a reminder each summer for families to update their information in Renweb as necessary. I understand that I am ultimately responsible for the completeness and accuracy of this information.
- All financial obligations from the current school year must be paid in full by the end of May. I may adjust my FACTS payments within a 30 day period by contacting FACTS directly. Any requests for payment plan adjustments beyond 30 days must be submitted to the Head of School in writing and include supporting documentation for the request (i.e. loss of wages).
- All financial obligations must be current and remain current for my student to participate in mission trips, graduation, athletics, drama, and other events as determined by the Head of School. Financial obligations must also be current to allow access to report cards, transcripts, ordering lunch, Teams, and Renweb. My student is not allowed to register or try out for athletics or drama productions if my FACTS account is past due at the time of registration.
- If financial obligations are more than two months overdue, my student cannot attend PHCS until the outstanding balance has been paid in full.
- A FACTS account that is overdue 30 days on June 30th will result in the automatic withdrawal of my student from the upcoming school year, and my student is not guaranteed a spot when I bring the account current.
- If my FACTS account has non-sufficient funds on my payment date, FACTS will charge me a \$30 NSF fee and attempt to withdraw again.
- A financial aid application is available through FACTS. Families who have completed all components of the financial aid application by the deadline and who qualify for needs-based aid will receive notice of the award before the end of January. Financial aid is designed as a supplement only to the family's contribution. Families are expected to reapply for financial aid every year based on need. FACTS will charge each family a \$35 fee to complete the application.
- By signing the continuous enrollment contract, I agree to compensate PHCS for a grade-level educational program that meets the requirements as an MSDE approved non-public school, regardless of the format (virtual or in-person). While it is our desire to provide a quality educational experience with instruction in a face-to-face environment, situations may arise that are outside of the school's reasonable control or that of Perry Hall Baptist Church, of whom PHCS is a ministry, including but not limited to government regulation or order, war, fire, earthquake, hurricane, or similar acts of God, epidemic, pandemic, quarantine, or other calamity declared or undeclared that require the school to suspend in-person learning. In such cases and when PHCS determines that remote instruction is warranted and attainable, standard tuition payments and policies will continue to apply.

Program Fee Details

A Program Fee will be included in monthly FACTS payment. Any remaining funds from events listed below will accrue with the class to offset the costs of special events in grades 5, 8 and 12. PTF and Extra-Curricular activities such as Fall Fun Day, Athletics, Drama, Student Government, etc. are not included in the Program Fee.

PreK School Fee includes: Two Field Trips, Field Day, End-of-Year Party, Mom's Celebration, Cot Sheets and Cot Maintenance.

Lower School Fee includes: Christmas Party, Two Field Trips, Field Day, End-of-Year Party.

Middle School Fee includes: Unity Day, Christmas Party, One Class Field Trip, Spiritual Emphasis Week, Field Day, End-of-Year Party.

High School Fee includes: Unity Day, Christmas Party, Spiritual Emphasis Week, Field Day, End-of-Year Party, Mission Trip Deposit (grades 9-11), and Graduation for Seniors.
